The primary tutoring focus is on core classes in these areas and on writing across the curriculum. Peer tutors create an inviting learning environment, model learning methods, allow student clients to practice learning skills, and nurture ongoing and emerging skills. The ACT offers both online and face-to-face appointments.
