

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (BSIT)

Program Overview

The B.S. Information Technology (BSIT) program provides students with a combination of knowledge, hands-on experience, and application of theory to support their employment in the field of Information Technology. The curriculum emphasizes quantitative and communication skills as well as providing a basic foundation in understanding the business process and the role of Information Technology in supporting that process. Computer science and information technology graduates find jobs in a wide array of occupations including software engineering, application, game, and web programming, network administration and security, and database administration. Because computers are becoming more and more pervasive, computer science and information technology jobs are available in almost every field. According to the US Department of Labor, computer science and information technology job opportunities are expected to grow at approximately 22% through 2020, which is much faster than the average for all occupations.
