Waivers are not guaranteed and must be approved by the MBA/MSOL Admissions Committee. Applicants who are granted a testing waiver will only be offered **provisional admission** to the MBA or MSOL program.

1. Previously earned graduate or terminal degree (e.g., PhD, MD, JD, MS MA), or
2. Previously earned BBA or BSBA degree with a minimum 3.25 GPA, or
3. A combination of an undergraduate grade point average of 3.00 or higher and seven or more years of significant managerial experience. A written statement of professional/managerial experience is required.
