

VETERANS AND DEPENDENTS

Columbus State University allows students who are using Veteran Educational Benefits to enroll, and will not impose any penalty, including the assessment of late fees, the denial of access to classes or other services due to the delayed disbursement of funding from the Department of Veterans Affairs. Students must provide the Military-Connected Student Services Office, Schuster 117, with a copy of their Certificate of Eligibility or Statement of Benefits provided as provided by the Department of Veterans Affairs. Approved students who are receiving less than 100% of tuition and fees covered by the Department of Veterans Affairs, must pay the remaining balance by the deadline as stated by the Student Financial Services Office.
